

Animal Welfare Licences – fees and costs

Fees apply for licences between 1 April 2010 and 31 March 2011

| Type of Licence | Cost | Other costs plus notes |

| Pet shop licence | £140 | Licences expire 31 December each year. |
| Animal boarding licence | £140 | Licences expire 31 December each year. |
| Animal boarding licence (pet sitting) | £92 | Licences expire 31 December each year. |
| Dog breeding licence | £140 | Licences expire 31 December each year. |
| Riding establishment licence | £182 | Licences run for one year from date of issue. Annual veterinary inspection necessary and the licence holder is required to reimburse the council for these costs. |
| Dangerous wild animal licence | £118 | Licences expire 31 December each year. Plus the reimbursement of veterinary inspection fees. |
| Zoo licence (zoos with 14(2) dispensation) | £900 | Licences run for 6 years from date of issue. Zoo veterinary inspection fees to be reimbursed (take place every 3 years or as advised). 14(2) dispensation is granted by DEFRA where the collection is of a sufficiently small size and nature that the inspection can take place with a single inspector. |
| Zoo licence (other) | POA | Licences run for 6 years from date of issue. Zoo inspection fees to be reimbursed (take place every 3 years or as advised). |
