

**PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004  
THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL DEVELOPMENT)  
(ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2004**

**Notice of adoption of the Brentford Area Action Plan<sup>1</sup>**

In accordance with Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that The London Borough of Hounslow Brentford Area Action Plan (BAAP) was adopted on **27 January 2009**. The BAAP includes objectives and policies, which seek to provide a spatial strategy for the continued regeneration of the Brentford area. It forms part of the Borough's Development Plan.

The BAAP was submitted to the Secretary of State on 20 July 2007 and considered by an independent Inspector at Examination in April/May 2008. The Inspector's Report was published on 31 October 2008 and can be viewed at the locations set out below. The adopted BAAP incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the BAAP may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

An application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than the end of the period of six weeks of the date of the adoption of this BAAP, i.e. by **10 March 2009**.

Copies of this Adoption Notice, the BAAP, the Sustainability Appraisal and Adoption Statement, the Inspector's Report and the BAAP Submission documents are available for public inspection, free of charge, at the following locations:
