About us

The course is run under the supervision of the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health and is recognised industry wide. You will be taught by one or more Environmental Health Officers from Hounslow's food team who will be on hand to explain and answer your questions.

About the course

Successful completion of the training and assessment will enable candidates to understand:

- The meaning of food safety
- The laws that apply to food businesses and food handlers
- Food hazards and food poisoning
- How to take product and equipment temperatures
- The importance of controlling food temperatures
- Correct storage of food
- The importance of good personal hygiene
- Cleaning and disinfection in food premises
- Design and use of food premises and equipment

The course takes place over one day at the end of which there is an examination consisting of 30 multiple-choice questions. You must get 20 answers right to pass.

The course will be run in English. The exam paper is in English but a limited range of other languages are available. Please contact us for further information. 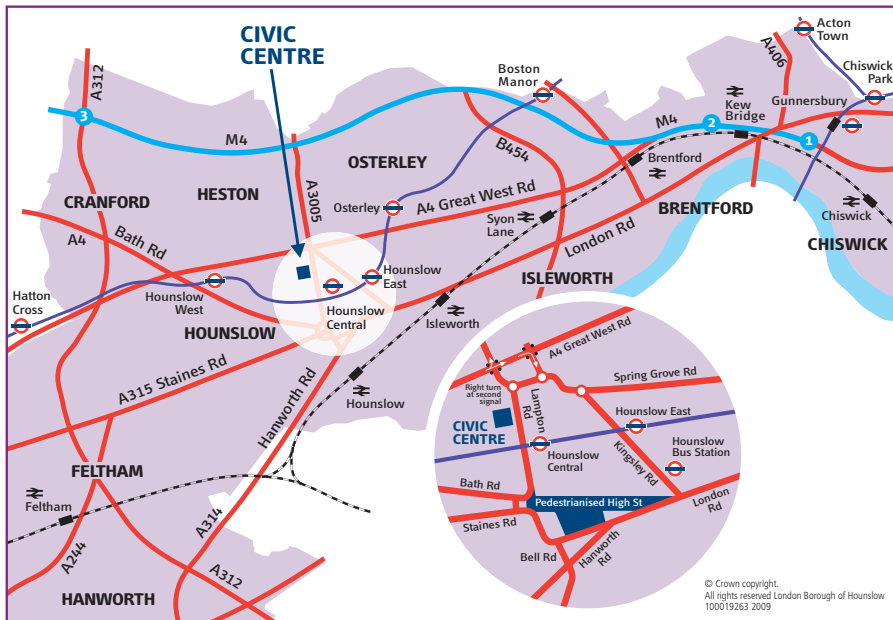
British Rail
