Figure 1: Map of pharmacies in Hounslow

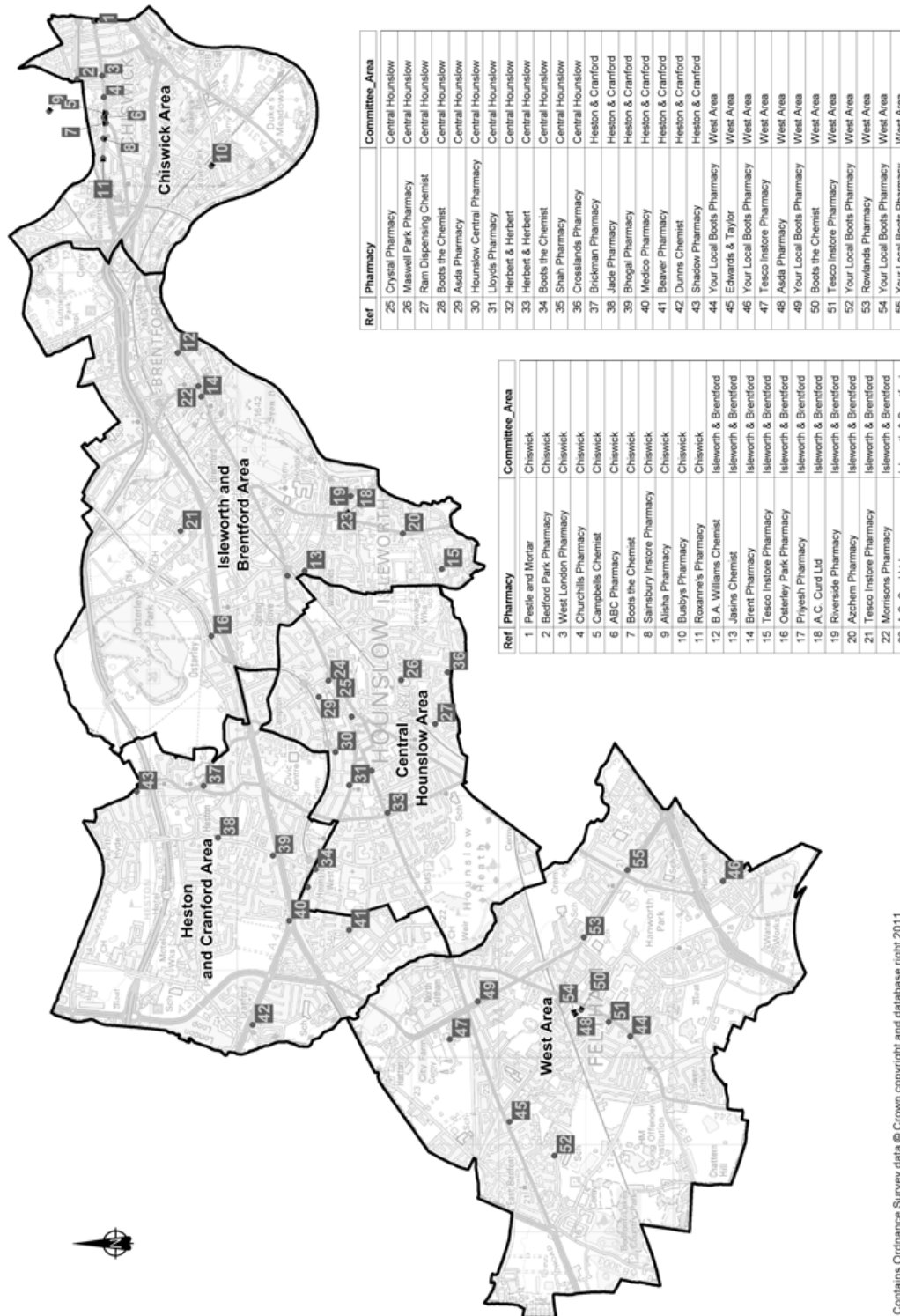
