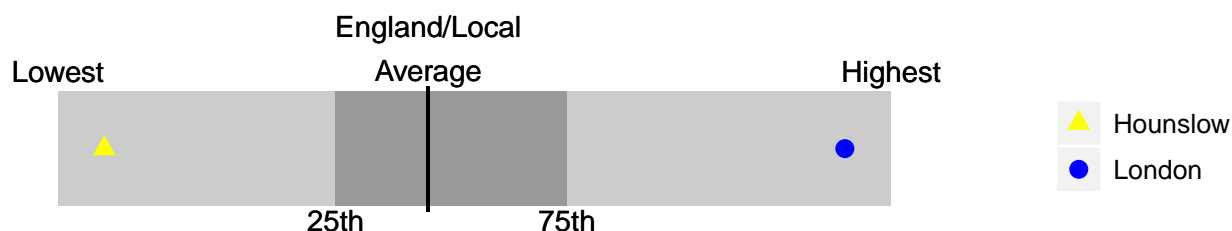

% of vulnerable people who feel very or fairly safe in their own home	65%

Figure 1: Map showing the areas of Hounslow where crimes committed against youthful victims are more frequent

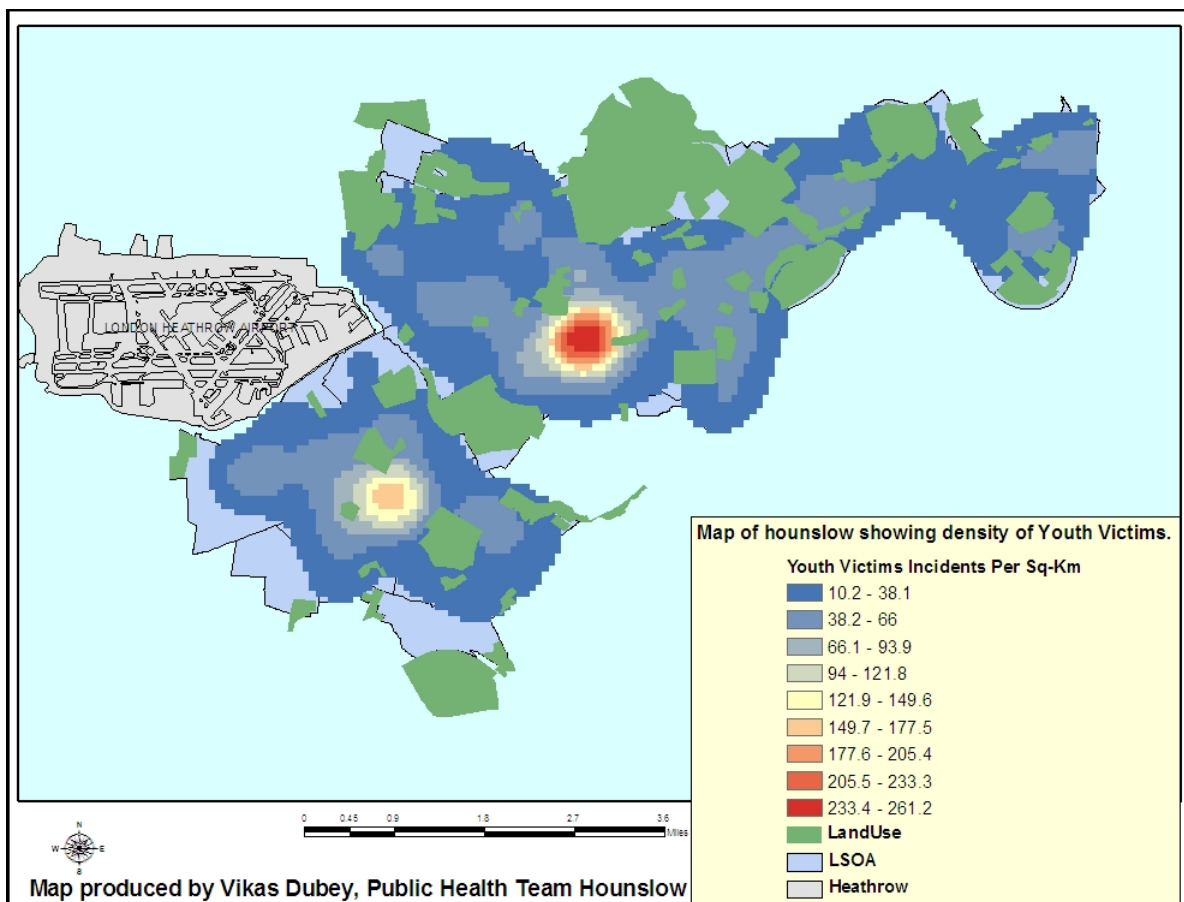


Figure 2: Map showing the areas of Hounslow where domestic victims are more frequent

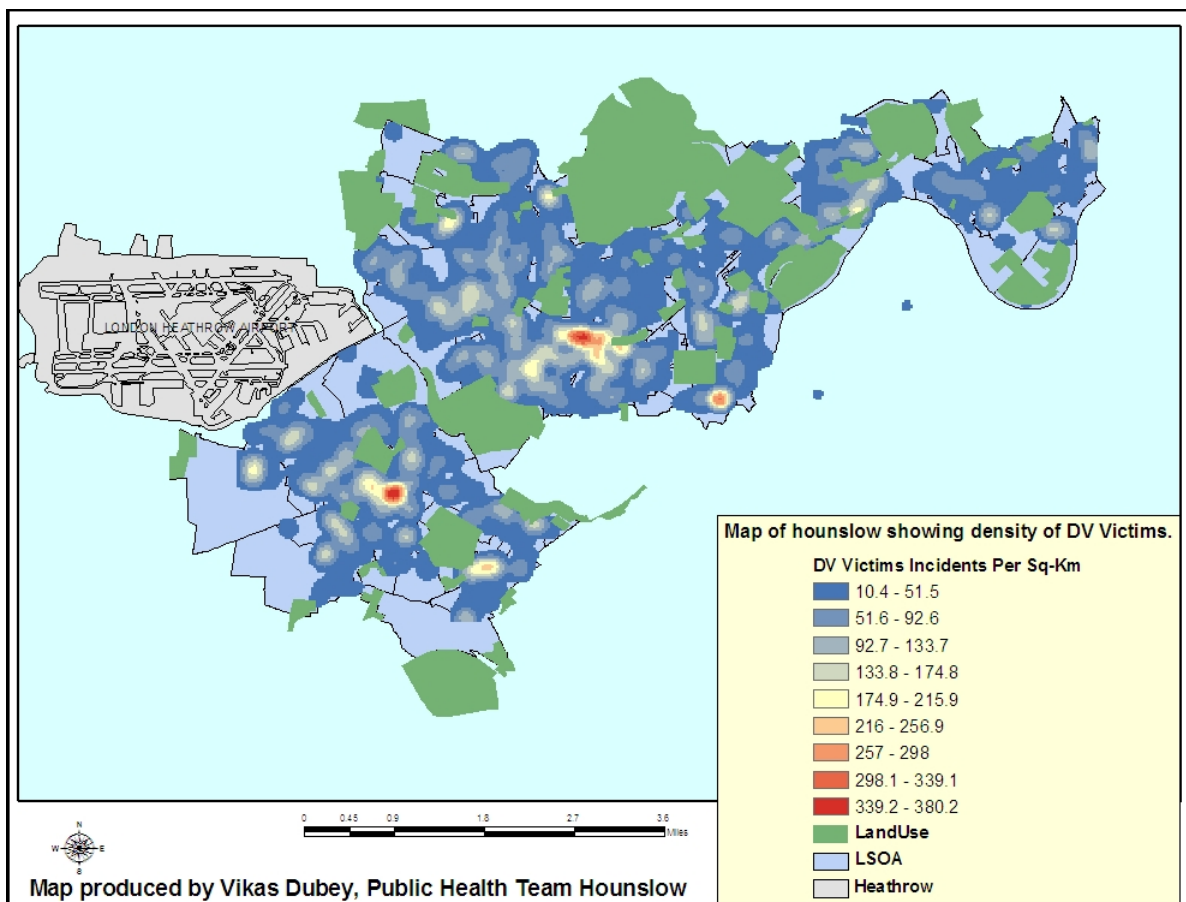


Figure 3: Map showing the areas of Hounslow where victims of violence are more frequent
