PROVISION OF VEHICLE CROSSOVER - BEDFONT LANE, FELTHAM

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BEDFONT LANE CONTROLLED PARKING SCHEME

A. THE HOUNSLOW (BEDFONT LANE) (PARKING PLACES) (2009, No. 29) (AMENDMENT No.*) ORDER 20**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 45 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
2. It is necessary to amend the description of item no. 2 as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice, which designates a residents' parking place in the Traffic Order for the Bedfont Lane Parking Scheme to facilitate the provision of vehicle crossover at No. 115 Bedfont Lane, Feltham.
3. A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the Order of 2009, the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and a plan depicting the lengths of road to which the Order relates can be inspected until the end of 21 days from the date on which the notice is published online at www.hounslow.gov.uk or at the following locations and during the specified opening hours:
 - (a) Forms and Documents Counter at the London Borough of Hounslow main reception at the Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow TW3 4DN between the hours of 9.00am and 4.15pm Monday to Friday: and
 - (b) Feltham Library at The Centre, High Street, Feltham TW13 4GU between the hours of 9.00am to 8.00pm Monday and Thursday; 9.00am to 5.30pm Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday; and 9.30am to 5.30pm on Saturday.

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 51 and 124 of and Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended by the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking) Act 1986 and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Bedfont Lane) (Parking Places) (2009, No. 29) (Amendment No.) Order 20** and shall come into operation for all purposes on ** ***** 20**.

2. In this Order,

“the Order of 2009” means the London Borough of Hounslow (Bedfont Lane) (Parking Places) (No. 29) Order 2009^b; and

the expression “enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred by the coming into operation of the Order, the Order of 2009 shall have affect as though the item in Schedule 7 to that Order numbered 2 there was substituted with items similarly numbered and set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.

SCHEDULE 1

In relation to a parking place referred to in this Schedule, the expression "permitted hours" means the period between 9.30 am and 6.30 pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive, any such day not being a Sunday or a public holiday.

Parking places in respect of which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid residents' permit or a valid residents' visitor parking card.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Hounslow (Bedfont Lane) (Parking Places) (No. 29) Order 2009 designated parking places in streets in the vicinity of Bedfont Lane, Feltham in the London Borough of Hounslow at which charges may be made by the Council of the Borough for vehicles authorised by that Order to be left in those parking places during the permitted hours.

This Order amends the Order of 2009 by the substitution of a residents' parking place in Bedfont Lane, Feltham for the provision of a vehicle crossover to No. 115 Bedfont Lane, Feltham.
