Revised Speed Limits - Windmill Lane, Brentford

The London Borough of Hounslow (Speed Limits) (No.*) Order 20**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above Order under section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Speed Limit Order would be to impose a speed limit of 40mph in the length of Windmill Lane from a point 313 metres north of the centre line of Jersey Road to the borough boundary with the London Borough of Ealing.
3. A copy of; the proposed Order; the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order; a plan which shows the lengths of road to which the Order relates, can be inspected at the following locations and during the opening hours shown until the end of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published.

Statement of Reasons

The proposals are to reduce the National Speed Limit of 60mph for a single carriageway road to improve road safety for all road users.

There have been a number of speed related accidents in Windmill Lane and it is anticipated that a reduction in the speed limit should reduce accident numbers and casualties.

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order :-

1. This Order shall come into operation on ** ***** 20** and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Speed Limits) (No.*) Order 20**.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on any lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. The provisions specified in article 3 above shall not apply in respect of any vehicle on any occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if observance of that provision would hinder the use of the vehicle.

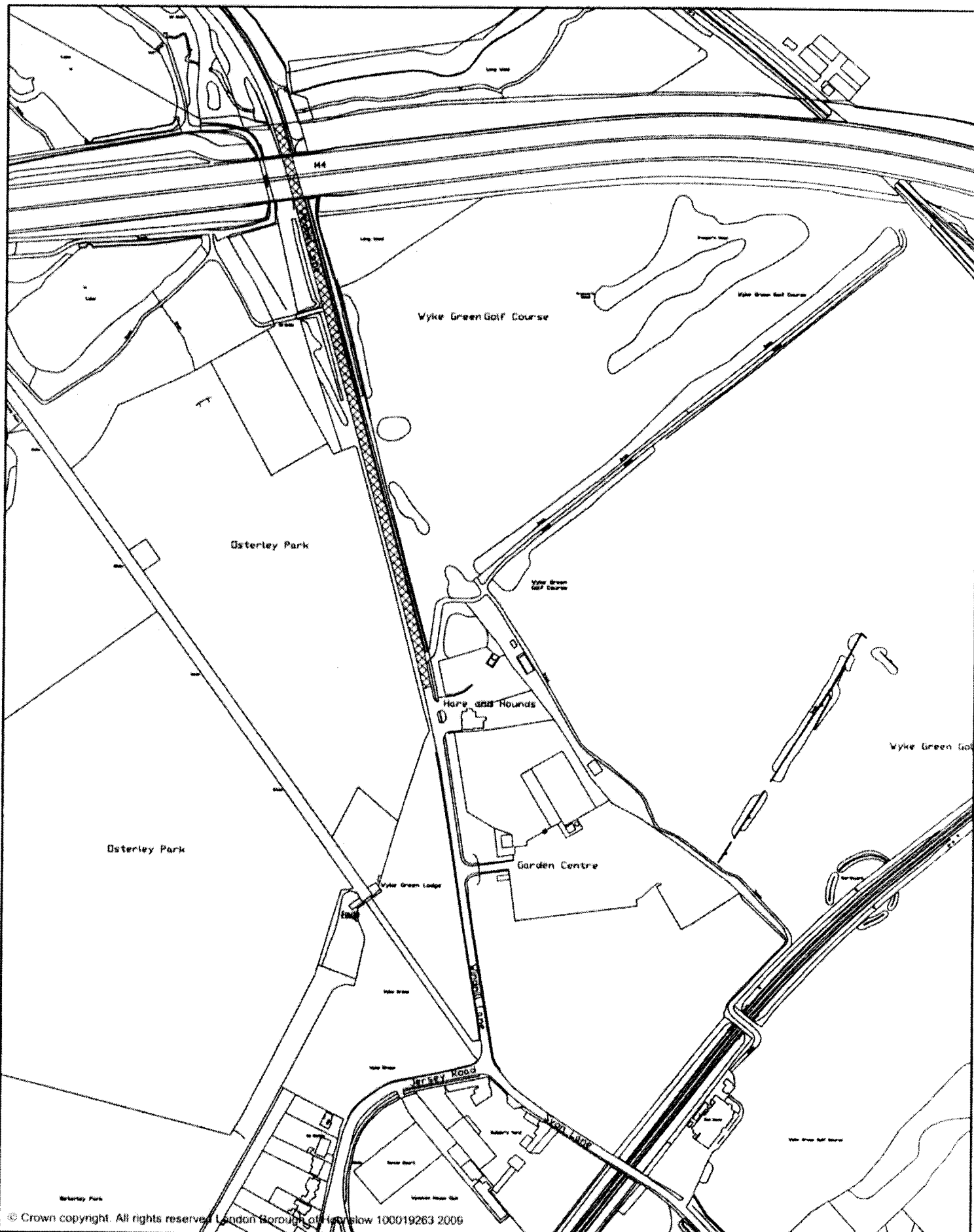
