#### WHAT IS AN EP?

## WHAT WILL HAPPEN WHEN YOU SEE AN EP?

- An EP will talk to you about what you like and don't like in school
- We may play some games or do some drawings with you
- We may do some puzzles or word games or reading and number work

# WHERE WILL I SEE AN EP?

- In a quiet place in school
- In the classroom to see what you or other children are doing

#### WHAT HAPPENS AFTERWARDS?

- We will think of some ways to help you and talk about these with you or your teacher, your parents or carers
- We may come and see you again to see how you are getting on
