Introduction

Welcome to the **Feltham Arenas Parklands Public Consultation**.

Following feedback from our previous public consultation in December 2016, the London Borough of Hounslow are looking to implement the first stage of works from the Feltham Arenas Parklands Masterplan. Phase 1 will **prioritise improvements in access and security**, with a particular focus on reducing crime and anti-social behaviour.

The following set of display boards show the Phase 1 proposals within Feltham Arenas Parklands, and we are very keen to hear what you think. Please make sure that you complete a **comments form** on these proposals before you leave.



Phase 1 works include the following priorities:

- Key pedestrian entrances to the park to be made more attractive and welcoming to pedestrians and cyclists, whilst restricting motorbikes and mopeds.
- Two new pedestrian/cycle paths including an accessible path over the mound and two new footbridges across the Longford River.
- New lighting along the proposed new primary path and improvements to lighting along the existing footpath on the eastern boundary.
- Improvements to the park frontage at Hounslow Road entrance, a new cricket pitch within Feltham Park, and relocated football pitches on Glebelands.
- Vegetation clearance and better management of trees and shrubs to improve sightlines around key entrances and along pathways.
