

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW MOORING BYELAWS

Notice is hereby given that the Mayor and Burgesses of the London Borough of Hounslow have made new byelaws to control and regulate the mooring of boats on river frontages owned or managed by the Council abutting the tidal and non-tidal stretches of the River Thames. The new byelaws will come into force 15th July 2019.

Except in case of emergency or other avoidable cause the new byelaws will prohibit any person from mooring or permitting any boat to be moored for longer than a maximum period of 1 hour in any period of 24 consecutive hours without the Council's prior written consent. The byelaws cover river frontages at Boston Manor, River Brent; Kew Bridge, Strand on the Green; Watermans Park, Brentford High Street, Dukes Meadows.

The byelaws will be kept at the offices of the Council at Hounslow House, 7 Bath Road, Hounslow, TW3 3EB and will be open to inspection without payment on any weekday during usual business hours. Copies of the byelaws may also be purchased.
