

STATEMENT OF REPRESENTATION PROCEDURE AND AVAILABLITY OF DOCUMENTS THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL PLANNING) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 – REGULATION 19

Title of Document

Hounslow Local Plan Review: Great West Corridor Local Plan review (Volume 4), West of borough Local Plan review (Volume 3) and Hounslow Site Allocations (Volume 2).

Subject Matter and Area Covered

The London Borough of Hounslow is consulting on the Local Plan Review for the Great West Corridor, West of Borough and borough wide Site Allocations. The primary aims of the plans are to transform the borough's opportunity areas, to set out and allocate the required housing growth and other land use requirements for the borough and to produce policies for the determination of planning applications up to 2034.

Period of Publication for Representations

Representations of support or objection are invited for a period of 8 weeks from Tuesday 30th July until midnight Tuesday 24th September 2019.

Please note that representations received after this date may not be considered. Only representations received within this period have a statutory right to be considered by the Inspector at the Examination.

Representations at this stage should only be made on the legal and procedural compliance of the Hounslow Local Plan reviews, the soundness of the plans and whether the plans is in conformity with the Duty to Co-operate.

If you choose not to submit a completed consultation form, you must specifically request if you wish to participate in the Examination and be kept informed of the progress of the Local Plan Review.

What happens to the Representations?

Representations will be submitted to the Secretary of State and the Planning Inspectorate and considered as part of a public examination by an independent Planning Inspector. Any representations received after this date may not be considered. Only representations received within this period have a statutory right to be considered by the Inspector at the Examination.
