- 7. Applications to vote by post or postal proxy and to change or cancel existing postal, proxy or postal proxy arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
