Commentary:

In the financial year 2018/2019 the council secured over £6.3 million where the top three categories in terms of the size of contributions agreed were Open Space/ Leisure and Sports, Affordable Housing and Carbon Offset;

Total financial contributions received in this financial year through S106 monies amounted to around £4.5 million;

Benefits delivered through s106 contributions based on spend in 2018/2019 was over £4.8 million.

Allocations were approved in April 2018 for £1,306,840 of S106 funds.
