The Hounslow Early Help Hub aims to provide a single point of contact for all those working with children, young people and their families within the local community to provide effective support to families as soon as difficulties start, to prevent them from getting worse.

If you have any concerns about families which are below the threshold for safeguarding, contact your locality Early Help Practitioner in the first instance for guidance and support.

EARLY HELP HUB CAN OFFER:

- Case consultation for individual families
- Delivery of early help training and 1:1 coaching
- Co-ordination of regular early help events
- Support with using the new Early Help Module system
- Co-ordination of Community Action Partnership Panels
- Provide information on services or resources available
- Maintain a directory of on-line resources

EARLY HELP HUB DOES NOT OFFER:

- Undertake direct work with families
- Take the Lead Professional role for a family
- Complete a CFAN for a family
- Complete referrals to services or allocate services for families
