A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Loading Places) (Amendment No.44) Order 2020

- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow on 16 November 2020 made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into operation on 23 November 2020.
- 2. The general effect of the above Order will be to introduce a goods vehicle only loading bay outside Nos.1 to 9 Elm Tree Court, New Heston Road which would operate "at any time", maximum stay of 20 minutes, no return for one hour.
- 3. Documents giving further information of the Order can be viewed for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this Notice online at <u>hounslow.gov.uk</u> by typing in the term "traffic notices" in the search bar.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

- This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Loading Places) (2009, No.1) (Amendment No.44) Order 2020 and shall come into operation for all purposes on 23 November 2020.
- Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough of Hounslow (Loading Places) Order 2009^b shall have affect as though:



STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council is proposing to introduce a goods vehicle only loading bay outside Nos.1 to 9 Elm Tree Court, New Heston Road to provide a loading facility for local shops. The loading bay will operate 'at any time, maximum stay 20 minutes, no return for one hour.
