# **Modification Order**

The London Borough of Hounslow (No.45) Experimental Order Modification (No.1) Order 2020

Made on 7 December 2020 Coming into operation on 17 December 2020

The Assistant Director Transport, Parking and Environmental Strategy, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers provided by Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, hereby makes modifications to the London Borough of Hounslow (No.45) Experimental Order 2020<sup>b</sup> (hereinafter known as "the experimental Order"):

- This modification Order shall come into operation on 17 December 2020 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (No.45) Experimental Order Modification (No.1) Order 2020.
- 2. The experimental Order shall be modified such that no person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter the street specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 during the prohibited hours unless otherwise stated in column 3 of the said Schedule.
- 3. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, when making the experimental Order, gave notice on 26 October 2020 that if the provisions of the experimental Order continued in operation for a period of not less than six months, the Council will consider in due course whether they should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the said Act of 1984. The date by which a person wishing to object to or support the making of such an Order for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation in force is hereby varied to 17 June 2021.

## **Lionel Primary School – Notice of Modification**

### **Statement of Reasons**

The Council on 7 December 2020 introduced an experimental order to restrict motor vehicles accessing Lionel Primary School within the borough as part of its School Streets programme.

This Modification order will change the specified times that prohibited motor vehicles, except permit holders, can enter the above roads to 8.30am to 9.30am and 3.00pm to 4.00pm.

These measures are initially being introduced on an experimental basis for a period between 6-18 months to allow the assessment of any impact the access restrictions might have on the area and surrounding roads, and to revise the scheme if necessary within that time. A review will be carried out to assess their effectiveness and whether the timed access restrictions should be made permanent.
