ARTICLE 4(2) DIRECTIONS FOR PARTS OF THE BEDFORD PARK AND GUNNERSBURY PARK CONSERVATION AREAS

On the 29th March 2001 the London Borough of Hounslow made an Article 4(2) Direction on parts of the above conservation areas. I write to inform you that the Direction was confirmed on 24th July 2001 and enclose the formal notice of confirmation. I also apologise for not writing sooner.

The effect of this direction is that key permitted development rights, which you previously had, have been removed. The reason for the Direction is because the special character that originally led to designation of the conservation area is being eroded by unsympathetic alterations and extensions. The Direction means that you may be required to apply for planning permission for development which would previously have been permitted under the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995.

The permitted development rights which have been removed are set out below and will only affect development where it fronts onto a highway, open space or waterway.

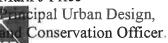
- 1) the enlargement, improvement or alteration of a dwellinghouse;
- 2) the erection of a porch outside any external door;
- 3) the formation of a any hardstanding fronting a highway;
- 4) the demolition or erection of walls, gates, fences or other enclosure; and
- 5) the painting of the exterior of any building.

In addition to the above the demolition, erection or alteration of chimneystacks will also require planning permission.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 1995

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4(2)

NOTICE IS GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow ('the Council') have made a Direction under Article 4(2) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 ('the Order'). The Direction was made on 29 March 2001 and was confirmed by the Council on 24 July 2001

The Direction applies to development of the descriptions set out in the First Schedule below at the properties listed in the Second Schedule below which are in the Bedford Park Conservation Area.

The effect of the Direction is that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to such development and such development shall not be carried out unless planning permission is granted for such development.

A copy of the Direction and of a map showing the properties to which it relates may be inspected free of charge at the Environmental Services Department Reception Desk Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow between the hours of 9.30am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday (except Public Holidays).

- 5. The erection, construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure, where the gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure would be within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse and would front a highway, waterway or open space

- Any building operation consisting of the demolition of the whole or any part of any gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure where the gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure is within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse and fronts a highway, waterway or open space
- 7. The painting of the exterior of any part of
 - (i) a dwellinghouse, or
 - (ii) any building or enclosure within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse, which fronts a highway, waterway or open space

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4(2)

WHEREAS the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow ('the Council') being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4(6) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 ('the Order'), is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the First Schedule below should not be carried out at the properties listed in the Second Schedule below which are in the Gunnersbury Park Conservation Area and shown (for the purposes of identification only) shaded on the attached plan, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by Article 4(2) of the Order hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development specified in the First Schedule to this Direction in respect of the land specified in the Second Schedule

THIS DIRECTION is made under Article 4(2) of the Order and in accordance with Article 6(7) of the Order shall remain in force until 29 September 2001 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless it has been confirmed by the Council

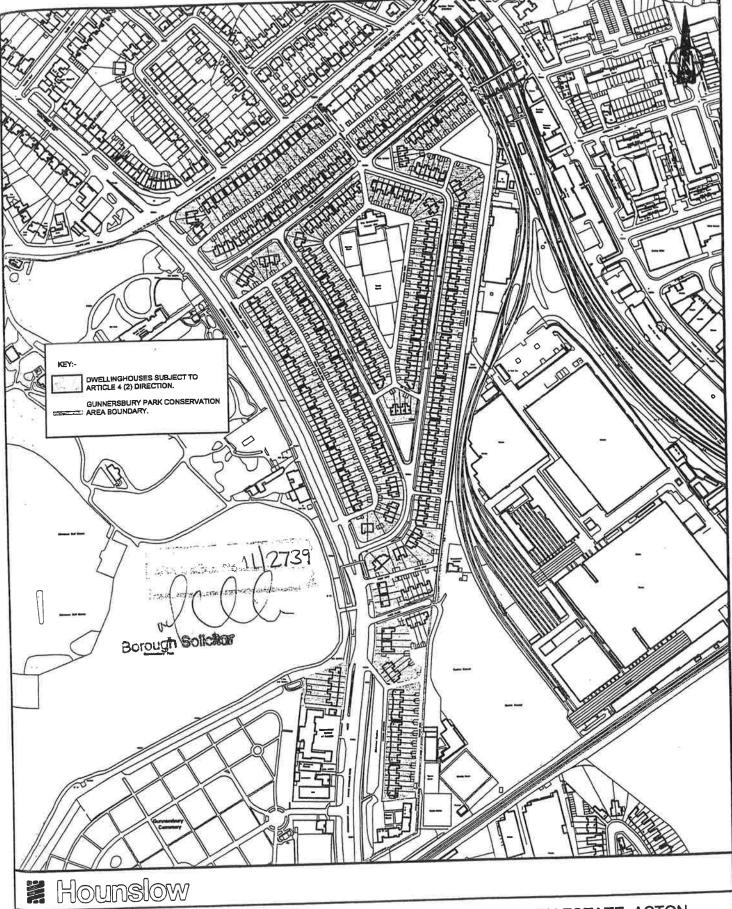
