### **Cycle Improvements – Cranford Lane (Northfield Road to Redwood Estate)**

- A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.\*\*) Order 20\*\*
- 1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general effect of the proposed order would be to introduce "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines) on Cranford Lane, between Northfield Road and the Redwood Estate, to prevent obstructive parking, maintain access to the cycle lanes, and retain space for two-way motor traffic movements.

- 4. This Order further amends the Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2008 by amending waiting restrictions in Cranford Lane, Cranford.






#### STATEMENT OF REASONS


The Council is introducing a scheme to provide mandatory cycle lanes and other improvements to cycle facilities, including additional cycle logo road markings, widening of advisory lanes (where it is necessary that they be retained), lengthened dropped kerbs where cycles move to/from the footway, removal of traffic islands and alterations to the position of speed cushions, on Cranford Lane between Nos. 198/200 and the access road to the Redwood estate.

The purpose of the scheme is to provide improved cycle facilities, to promote and encourage active travel as part of the Council's Local Implementation Plan.

As part of the scheme, the Council is introducing changes to waiting restrictions on Cranford Lane throughout the extent noted above. The restrictions are required to prevent obstructive parking in the cycle lanes and on approaches to pedestrian refuge islands, and to maintain two way flows for motor traffic, including buses.
