### Waiting restrictions, The Promenade Chiswick

- A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 299) Order 2022
- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives notice that on 17 January 2022 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into operation on 22 January 2022.
- The general effect of the above Order will be to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) on The Promenade, on both sides for its entire length except where signed as parking bays.
- 3. Documents giving further information of the Order can be viewed for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice online at <a href="https://example.com/hourslow.gov.uk">hourslow.gov.uk</a> by typing in the term "traffic notices" in the search bar.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.299) Order 2022

Made on 18 January 2022 Coming into operation on 22 January 2022

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup> as amended, and of all other powers thereunto hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order, which shall come into operation on 22 January 2022, may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment No.299) Order 2022.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2008<sup>b</sup> shall have effect as though:
  - a) the item numbered 1241 in Schedule 1 to that Order was substituted with the item similarly numbered and set out in the Schedule to this Order.

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## Waiting restrictions in The Promenade, Chiswick

### **Statement of Reasons**

The London Borough of Hounslow (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2021 regulates the provision of off-street parking within the borough.

Formal parking are being introduced on The Promenade, and the proposed Order would introduce a "no waiting at any time" restriction on all parts of The Promenade except where parking bays have been signed, in order to prevent parked vehicles causing obstruction and congestion.
