## Changes to Access Restriction Times – Grove Park Road, Hartington Road, Strand-on-the-Green and Thames Road, Chiswick

### A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Prescribed Route) (2018, No.2) (Amendment No.20) Order 2022

- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives notice that on 24 January 2022 it made the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into operation on 27 January 2022.
- 2. The general effect of the proposed order is to amend the hours of the existing access only restriction on Grove Park Road (between its junctions with Grove Park Terrace and Thames Road), Strand-on-the-Green and Thames Road, and the permit holders only access restriction on Hartington Road (south of Chiswick Quay). The change to the hours of the above restrictions is from "at any time" to 8am to 7pm, Mondays to Saturdays.


# Proposed Changes to Access Restriction Times – Grove Park Road, Hartington Road, Strand-on-the-Green and Thames Road, Chiswick

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS

The purpose of the proposed changes to the access restriction times on Grove Park Road, Hartington Road, Strand-on-the-Green and Thames Road, Chiswick is to bring the operational times into line with the access restriction times being trialled on Staveley Road, Chiswick. This will have the effect of creating a uniform timed restriction on motor vehicles accessing the South Chiswick area from the A205 and the A316, therefore reducing confusion around the times that motorists are permitted to use the aforementioned roads.


