Waiting restrictions, Fishers Lane, Chiswick

- A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.** 299) Order 20**
- B. The London Borough of Hounslow (Mid Chiswick) (Parking Places) (No. 1) (Amendment No.**) Order 20**
- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above Orders under sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general effect of the above Orders will be to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) as currently marked, on the west side of Fishers Lane from a point 15 metres north of the north-eastern kerb-line of Chiswick Common Road and a point 40 metres north of that kerb-line.
- 3. Documents giving further information of the proposed Orders can be viewed for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice online at hounslow.gov.uk by typing in the term "traffic notices" in the search bar.
- 4. WAITING RESTRICTIONS, FISHER'S LANE, CHISWICK

Statement of Reasons

In July 2020 Ealing and Hounslow Councils jointly introduced an Experimental Traffic Management Order banning general motor traffic using Fisher's Lane, under the railway between its junctions with Chiswick Common Road and South Parade, Ealing. Local buses, cyclists and emergency vehicles were exempted from the restriction.

The "Pay and Display" parking bays in this section of the road were replaced with "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines), in light of the restriction on access by motor vehicles.

In January 2022, the access restriction was made permanent under a joint traffic order between Ealing and Hounslow.

As noted above, the restriction on access by motor vehicles renders the "Pay and Display" parking bays in this part of Fishers Lane obsolete. The London Borough of Hounslow therefore proposes to make permanent the "no waiting at any time" restrictions (double yellow lines), as currently marked on the west side of Fisher's Lane.
