#### BY THIS ORDER

- 1. The Council authorises the stopping up of highway at Burlington Close (part), Feltham, TW14 8JU as described in Schedule 1 to this Order and shown edged in red on the attached plan as the Council is satisfied that this is necessary in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this Order to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by the Council on 6 March 2020 under planning reference number P/2019/3977 (00174/B/P1) and any subsequent permissions granted under section 73 of the Act which vary or amend this planning permission which do not affect the areas being stopped up
