NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A STOPPING UP ORDER SECTION 247 TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

NOTICE is hereby given that the London Borough of Hounslow ("the Council") acting in its capacity as local highway authority proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") authorising the stopping up of the highways described in the First Schedule below and shown cross hatched in red on Drawing No. 9_2105-S-SK-04-001 attached to the Order.

IF THE PROPOSED ORDER IS MADE, the stopping up will enable the development described in the Second Schedule to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council under Part III of the Act on 5 August 2022 under planning reference 00015/L/S2 (P/2021/4783) and any subsequent permissions granted under section 73 of the Act which vary or amend this planning permission which do not affect the area being stopped up and will be for no other purpose.

ANY OBJECTION to the making of the proposed Order must be made in writing within a period of 33 days commencing on **8 December 2023** by writing to the Assistant Director Transport, Parking & Environmental Strategy, London Borough of Hounslow, 7 Bath Road, Hounslow, TW3 3EB quoting reference: 'Charlton House Stopping Up Order'.

The Council may disclose the substance of any objection made to the making of the Order to other persons affected by it and that those persons may wish to communicate with the objector.

If no objections are duly made to the making of the Order, or if any objections are withdrawn, the Council may make the Order as an unopposed Order. Any objections duly made and which are not withdrawn will be referred to the Mayor of London.

THIS NOTICE is given by virtue of Section 252 of the above Act.

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THIS ORDER is made by the London Borough of Hounslow ("the Council") acting in its capacity as a local highway authority and in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") as amended by Section 270 and Schedule 22 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The Council authorises the stopping up of the highway described in the First Schedule to this Order and shown on the Deposited Plan, in order to enable the development described in the Second Schedule to this Order to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act by the Council on 5 August 2022 under reference number 00015/L/S2 (P/2021/4783) and any subsequent permissions granted under section 73 of the Act which vary or amend this planning permission which do not affect the areas being stopped up.
- 2. Where immediately before the date of this Order there is any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across any area of highway authorised to be stopped up under this Order then, subject to Section 261(4) of the Act, those statutory undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of that apparatus after that area of highway is stopped up as they had immediately before the making of this Order.
- 3. References to the "**Deposited Plan**" shall mean the plan numbered 9 2105-S-SK-04-001 deposited at the main reception London Borough of Hounslow, Hounslow House, 7 Bath Road, Hounslow, TW3 3EB.

DATE OF COMING INTO FORCE

4. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252(10) of the Act, and may be cited as London Borough of Hounslow Stopping up of Highway at Charlton House, Brentford TW8 0NG Order 2023.
