## School Street – Quakers Lane, Isleworth

### A. The London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) (Amendment No.9) Order 2024

- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow gives notice that on 10 April 2024 it made the abovementioned Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order will come into operation on 15 April 2024.
- 2. The general effect of the School Streets Order will be to prohibit motor vehicles from using Quakers Lane, Isleworth, between its junction with London Road, Isleworth and the railway line, between the hours of 8.15am and 9.30am, and 2.45pm and 3.45pm, Monday to Friday, during school term time. Exemptions would apply for emergency services vehicles, visitors to premises within the zone, Blue Badge holders for access to Isleworth & Syon School, Marlborough Primary School, Osterley Park Day Nursery, Quaker's Meeting House and The Green School, easily recognisable delivery vehicles (e.g. supermarket lorries), and school staff.
- 3. Documents giving further information of the Order can be viewed for a period of 6 weeks from the date of this Notice online at <u>hounslow.gov.uk</u> by typing in the term "traffic notices" in the search bar.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any other relevant regulations made thereunder have not been compiled with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

- 3 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) Order 2021<sup>3</sup> shall have effect as though the item numbered 66 in the Schedule to this Order were added to Schedule 1 to that Order.

## **Statement of Reasons**

## **Quakers Lane, Isleworth – Access Restriction**


The council is consulting on proposals to introduce a restriction on motor vehicles accessing from using Quakers Lane, Isleworth, Quakers Lane, Isleworth, between its junction with London Road, Isleworth and the railway line, during school start and finish times (Monday – Friday 8.15-9.30am and 2.45-3.45pm) as part of its School Streets programme.

Exemptions will be introduced for blue badge holders, easily recognisable delivery vehicles (e.g. supermarket lorries), and school staff.

The School Street concept is aimed at tackling problems associated with traffic around schools at drop-off and pick-up times, notably road safety concerns, poor air quality, and inconvenience to residents, by restricting motor traffic access in the immediate vicinity of a school access.

The restrictions are aligned with Hounslow Council's aim to promote active and healthy communities by:

- Improving road safety for pupils, residents and visitors to the borough;
- Reducing pollution in the area, including particulates, which especially impact young people;
- Increasing walking, cycling and active lifestyles and decreasing motor traffic journeys - by pupils and their parents and guardians;
- Minimising anti-social behaviour arising from inconsiderate parking and dangerous manoeuvres.





# London Borough of Hounslow Traffic Management Order

1997 No.6

The London Borough of Hounslow (Prescribed Route) (No.1) Order 1997

Made on 3 March 1997 Coming into operation on 10 March 1997

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended by section 8 and Schedule 5 of the Local Government Act 1985 (b) and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 10 March 1997 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Prescribed Route) (No.1) Order 1997.
- 2. In this Order -

"prohibited area" means that length of carriageway of Quakers Lane in the London Borough of Hounslow which lies between the northern kerb-line of London Road, Isleworth and a point 15 metres north of that kerb-line;

"prohibited hours" means the hours between 8.45am and 9.15am and between 3.15pm and 3.45pm on Mondays to Fridays (any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday).

- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the prohibited area during the prohibited hours.
- 4. Nothing in this Order shall apply -
  - (a) in relation to a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.

(c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in any road in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

# **Traffic Management Order**

2021 No.56

The London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) Order 2021

Made on 1 November 2021 Coming into operation on 8 November 2021

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

#### 1. Commencement and Citation

(1) This Order shall come into operation on 8 November 2021 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (School Streets) Order 2021.

#### 2. Interpretation

(1) In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

"Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow.

"permit holder" means any person who has been granted exemption by the Council from the prohibition in Article 3.

"prohibited hours" means the times shown in column 3 in the Schedule to this Order, on Mondays to Fridays during school term time.

"school term time" means those days of the year which have been determined as school days by the Council as Local Education Authority in accordance with Section 21 of the Education (No.2) Act 1986<sup>b</sup>.

#### 3. Prohibition

(1) Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter the street specified in column 2 of the Schedule during the prohibited hours.

#### 4. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing is this Order shall apply in respect of a person causing a motor vehicle to enter the prohibited area if:
  - a) it is being used by a permit holder
  - required to proceed in any road in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

- c) the vehicle is being used for at least one of the following purposes:
  - i) fire and rescue authority
  - ii) ambulance
  - iii) blood service
  - iv) providing a response to an emergency at the request of an NHS ambulance service;
  - v) bomb or explosive disposal;
  - vi) special forces;
  - vii) police;
  - viii) National Crime Agency.
- d) the vehicle is being used for the purposes of:
  - i) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any length of highway specified in Schedule 1; or
  - ii) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning, in any length of highway specified in Schedule 1, of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, or electricity, or of any electronic communications apparatus;
- (2) Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
