



**1 POET'S CORNER (Poor's Piece)**  
Poet's Corner (Poor's Piece) re-modelled for:  
a) Open community orchard  
b) Market garden social enterprise or training centre  
c) Space for picnics and community events

**2 WEST CAR PARK LAYOUT**


**11 EXISTING ATHLETICS TRACK**

- 26 DOG AREA**  
Existing dog enclosure area within Feltham Green, either:

  - a) Resize it so it is not so dominating within the Green
  - b) Relocate it to the south side of the pond

  - d) Remove it altogether and create a memorial Freddie Mercury garden
