The boathouse fronts onto the Thames foreshore and is in its own grounds, which are fenced. On one side of the site is another boathouse. On the other side and at the rear is a sports ground and its car park.

The boathouse has been partly demolished and is being rebuilt with a larger footprint than before. The redeveloped boathouse includes a new balcony, which will not be visible from any homes. The creation of the new balcony is the only reason for needing a variation to the club premises certificate. There will be no other changes to the way in which the club or its bar operates. Specifically, no parts of the Club Operating Schedule would be subject to change.

The structure of the boathouse is due to be finished in mid-October 2025 but it will then take some weeks to fit out the building. Although the variation is requested to take effect from 1 October, the bar is unlikely to be open before December at the earliest.

In accordance with the mandatory conditions, no alcohol will be supplied at less than the permitted price, there will be no irresponsible promotions, free potable water will be available from the bar, and alcohol will be supplied only in the permitted measures.

Apart from drinks being able to be consumed on the new balcony, the club and its bar will not be operating any differently from in the past. To the best of the club's knowledge, there have been no alcohol-related problems since the club first obtained a licence in 1951.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises will be monitored by CCTV cameras.

c) Public safety

Smoking is not allowed in the building.

The premises have a defibrillator and a first aid kit.

The premises will have a fire detection system and fire extinguishers..

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The new balcony will not be visible from any homes. The exit from the boathouse site is into the car park of the neighbouring sports ground, and the exit from the car park is onto a non-residential part of Hartington Road. Thus there is no likelihood of annoyance to local residents.

e) The protection of children from harm

There will be no activities that might give rise to concern in respect of children.

In accordance with the mandatory condition, all those serving behind the bar will be instructed to demand age verification for any potential purchaser who might be under age.



Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied except during permitted hours. In this condition, permitted hours means:

- a. On weekdays, 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- b. On Sundays, Christmas Day and On Good Friday, 12 noon to 10.30 p.m.
- c. On New Year's Eve, from the end of permitted hours on New Year's Eve to the start of the permitted hours on the following day.

d. On Christmas day, as provided by the rules of the club and notified in writing by the chairman or secretary of the club to the chief executive of the justices for the petty sessions area in which the premises are.

The said hours shall:

i. not exceed six and a half hours;

ii. not begin earlier than 12 noon;

iii. not end later than 10.30 p.m.

iv. provide for a break of at least 2 hours, including 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.

v. not extend for more than three and a half hours after 5 p.m.

The above restrictions do not prohibit:

(a) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises;

(b) during the first twenty minutes after the above hours, the taking of alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;

(c) during the first thirty minutes after the above hours, the consumption of the alcohol on the premises by persons taking meals there if the alcohol was supplied as ancillary to the meals;

(d) the supply to, or consumption by, any person of alcohol in any premises where they are residing.

e. On New Year's Eve from the end of permitted hours to the start of permitted hours on the following day (or, if there are no permitted hours on the following day, midnight on 31st December).
