The London Borough of Hounslow provides a free clinical waste collection service for LBH residents, collected by Medisort Ltd. Collections are made weekly, fortnightly, and monthly or on request as required.

If you require a clinical waste collection please complete the form overleaf. To ensure we understand the type of waste we are collecting we require your Community Nurse, GP or Consultant to sign the form.

Once we have processed your completed form we will contact you to confirm the provision of the service for you and to arrange the details of collection.
