# Weight Restriction – Alexandra Road, and Denbigh Road, Hounslow

### The London Borough of Hounslow (Weight Restriction) (No.1) Order 2025

- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives notice that, it made the above Order on 12 March 2025 under sections 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order will come into operation on 14 March 2025.
- 2. The general effect of the Order will be to introduce a weight limit to prohibit goods vehicles exceeding a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes except for loading from entering or proceeding on:
  - a) Alexandra Road; from the junction of Lampton Road, no access into Alexandra Road (eastbound direction); &
  - b) Denbigh Road; from the junction of Kingsley Road, no access into Denbigh Road (westbound direction).
- 3. Documents giving further information of the Order can be viewed for a period of six weeks from the date of this Notice online at hounslow.gov.uk by typing in the term "traffic notices" in the search bar.
- 4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or any provision contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Made on 12 March 2025 Coming into operation on 14 March 2025

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 14 March 2025 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Weight Restriction) (No.1) Order 2025.
- Interpretation

2.

Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment. In this Order:

"Council" means the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow;

"Bus", "Goods Vehicle", "Maximum Gross Weight" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>2</sup>; and

"Scheduled Street" means any street or section of a street listed in the schedule to this order.

#### **Restrictions**

3. No person shall cause any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 Tonnes, to enter any Scheduled Street;

- a) No person shall cause any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 Tonnes to enter Alexandra Road; from the junction of Lampton Road, no access into Alexandra Road (eastbound direction);
- b) No person shall cause any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 Tonnes to enter Denbigh Road; from the junction of Kingsley Road, no access into Denbigh Road (westbound direction)

#### **Exemptions**

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply in respect of:

a) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to sections 66 and 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

b) a vehicle being used for the purpose of laying, erection, alteration or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system in a Scheduled Street;

c) a vehicle being used for the for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the Scheduled Street;

d) a goods vehicle being used in connection with the loading or unloading of goods for an event authorised by the Council or its contracted events organiser to be held in a Scheduled Street;

e) any vehicle is being used for the purposes of accessing premises, residential or commercial, that are only accessible from the Scheduled Street;

f) any vehicle is making deliveries to, or collecting goods from, premises that are only accessible from the Scheduled Street;

g) a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade, or police purposes;

h) any vehicle is a Bus;

i) any vehicle is being used in the service of the Council in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that, in all the circumstances, it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that vehicle to enter in the Scheduled Street; and j) any person causing any vehicle to enter a Scheduled Street with the permission of the Council.

  - a) Alexandra Road; from the junction of Lampton Road, no access into Alexandra Road (eastbound direction)
  - b) Denbigh Road; from the junction of Kingsley Road, no access into Denbigh Road (westbound direction)

- a) No person shall cause any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 Tonnes to enter Alexandra Road; from the junction of Lampton Road, no access into Alexandra Road (eastbound direction);
- b) No person shall cause any vehicle, the Maximum Gross Weight of which exceeds 7.5 Tonnes to enter Denbigh Road; from the junction of Kingsley Road, no access into Denbigh Road (westbound direction)

#### **Exemptions**

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply in respect of:

# STATEMENT OF REASONS

# Alexandra Road and Denbigh Road, Hounslow – 7.5t Weight limit restrictions (except for loading)

#### DEFINITIONS

#### **Statement of Reasons**

As part of the Councils policy to deter HGV's from using unsuitable narrow roads to access deliveries made to Blenheim Centre. Alexandra Road is 4.9m wide when entering from Lampton Road, therefore unsuitable for large delivery vehicles. Similarly, the access from Kingsley Road and Denbigh Road junction is not suitable for HGVs as the road is narrow leading towards Alexandra Road. The Council plans on consulting proposals to introduce a 7.5t weight limit restrictions, except for loading.

There is existing vehicle barrier in Alexandra Road near the junction with Lansdowne Road, to deter vehicles accessing the Blenheim Centre, from Alexandra Road. This proposal will further enhance improvements, by deterring HGVs from residential roads and improve road safety and reduce noise / vibrations to the properties along this route.

Introduction of the HGV vehicle restriction at the two roads (Alexandra Road and Denbigh Road) will improve the flow (as there are limited passing gaps along the road) of traffic and maintain clear access.

The restriction is aligned with Hounslow Council's aim to promote active and healthy communities by:

- improving road safety for residents and visitors to the Borough.
- reducing pollution in the area, including particulates, which especially impact young people.

- minimising anti-social behaviour arising from inconsiderate parking and dangerous manoeuvres.
