Proposed Revocation of banned right turn and one-way restrictions– St Heliers Avenue, Hounslow

A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Revocations) Order 20**

- 1. The London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general effect of the Revocations Order would be to revoke:
 - a) one way restriction in that length of St Heliers Avenue, Hounslow which lies between the north-easter kerb-line of Wellington Road South and a point 10 metres northeast of that kerb line.
 - b) banned right turn restriction from St Heliers Avenue to Wellington Road South.

- 4.
