**A. The London Borough of Hounslow (Prescribed Routes) Order 20\*\***

1. The London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The general effect of the Prescribed Routes Order would be to consolidate a number of Prescribed Route Orders and also to revoke those that have been superseded or replaced by subsequent Orders and/or legislation. This is an administrative exercise that has no impact on any existing traffic restrictions within the borough.

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup> as amended and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (Prescribed Routes) Order 20\*\* and shall come into operation for all purposes on \*\* \*\*\*\*\* 20\*\*
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this order, the following orders are hereby revoked:

3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

“authorised person” means a traffic warden, a police community support officer, an accredited person, or a traffic marshal authorised by the Council where:

- a) “police community support officer” means a person who has been so designated by the Metropolitan Police Service as provided for by Section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002;

b) “accredited person” means a person who has been accredited by the Metropolitan Police Service under the Community Safety Accreditation Scheme as provided for by Section 41 of that Act; and

c) “traffic marshal” means a person trained to direct vehicular traffic.

and in any case whilst exercising the powers of a police community support officer or an accredited person that person is wearing an approved uniform as provided for by Section 42(2) of that Act.

“authorised person” means a police community support officer or an accredited person, where:

i) “police community support officer” means a person who has been so designated by the Metropolitan Police Service as provided for by Section 38 of the Police Reform Act 2002 , and

ii) “accredited person” means a person who has been accredited by the Metropolitan Police Service under the Community Safety Accreditation Scheme as provided for by Section 41 of that Act;

and in either case whilst exercising the powers of a police community support officer or an accredited person that person is wearing an approved uniform as provided for by Section 42(2) of that Act;

“Brentford Community Stadium Event Day” means any such day when an event is taking place at Brentford Community Stadium, Lionel Road South, Brentford where restrictions will come into operation four hours before an event starting and remain in operation until two hours after an event has finished;

“Council” means the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow;

“Forge Lane island site” means the triangle island at or adjacent to the junction of Forge Lane and Green Lane, Hanworth;

“goods vehicle”, “local bus” “pedal cycle” and “taxi” have the same meanings as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2015<sup>a</sup>; and

“Highways England” means the company appointed as a highway authority by the Secretary of State for Transport

“Moto” means Moto Hospitality Limited incorporated and register in England and Wales with company number 00734299.

“New Road Island Site” means the triangle island at or adjacent to the junction of New Road and Hounslow Road, Feltham”

“permit holder” means any driver whose vehicle is listed on the list of authorised road user vehicle registration numbers held by the London Borough of Hounslow. The vehicle registration numbers being supplied to the London Borough of Hounslow by Moto.

“school term time” means those days of the year which have been determined as school days by the Council as Local Education Authority in accordance with Section 21 of the Education (No.2) Act 1986<sup>b</sup>”

“traffic officer” has the meaning given in section 100(5) of the 1984 Act.

“Travelodge” means Travelodge Limited incorporated and register in England and Wales with company number 07208249.

4. a) No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 in a direction other than that specified in column 3, unless otherwise stated in column 4 of the said Schedule.

- b) No person shall cause any vehicle to enter a road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 at the location so specified, unless otherwise stated in column 3 of the said Schedule.
  - c) No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in any length of road as specified in column 2 of Schedule 3 to turn right into any length of road specified in column 3 of Schedule 3 during the hours specified in column 4 unless otherwise stated in column 5 of the said Schedule.
  - d) No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in any length of road as specified in column 2 of Schedule 4 to turn left into any length of road specified in column 3 of Schedule 3 during the hours specified in column 4 unless otherwise stated in column 5 of the said Schedule.
  - e) Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 5 shall upon reaching the junction with the road specified in column 3 proceed in the direction specified in column 4 during the hours specified in column 5 unless otherwise stated in column 6 of the said Schedule.
  - f) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in any length of road as specified in column 2 of Schedule 6 to make a U-turn, so as to proceed in the opposite direction to which the vehicle was proceeding.
  - g) No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 7 with the overall load width of which together with the load (if any) carried thereon exceeds the width specified in column 3 unless otherwise stated in column 4 of the said Schedule.
  - h) No person shall cause any vehicle to enter into any length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 8 during the hours specified in column 3 unless otherwise stated in column 4 of the said Schedule.
  - i) No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed in any length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 9 during the hours specified in column 3 unless otherwise stated in column 4 of the said Schedule.
  - j) No person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter or leave any road specified in column 2 of Schedule 10 at the location specified in column 3 unless otherwise stated in column 4 of the said Schedule.
5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to:
- a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - b) in relation to a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or
  - c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to sections 66 and 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
6. Nothing in Articles 4(h) and 4(i) shall apply to:
- a) a vehicle being used in the service of the local authority for the purpose of collecting refuse, the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction or cleansing of the highway;
  - b) a vehicle being used for the purpose of laying, erection, alteration or repair of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system;
  - c) a vehicle being used for the for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the street or length of street specified in Schedules 8 and 9;
7. Nothing in Article 4(i) shall apply to:

- a) a goods vehicle being used in connection with the loading or unloading of goods for an event authorised by the Council or its contracted events organiser to be held in a street specified in Schedule 10;
- b) a goods vehicle being used in connection with the loading or unloading of goods for the setting up or taking down of a market stall or pitch, licensed by the Council and situated in a street or length of street specified in Schedule 9, between the hours of 5.30pm and 8.30am; or
- c) a vehicle being used in connection with the promotion or sale of goods by a person who is licensed by the Council to sell or promote goods from a stationary vehicle on a pitch situated in a street or length of street specified in Schedule 9.
