The premises comprises a ground floor customer service area with seating, kitchen and preparation facilities, storage, and staff areas. The venue provides hot food, non-alcoholic and Indian Street food and Chaii beverages, and takeaway services. The layout is designed to be accessible, safe, and suitable for family-friendly dining in a busy town centre location.

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

Global Gourmet Ltd T/A Karak Chaii is committed to running the premises in a safe, responsible, and community-friendly manner. All staff will be trained in licensing requirements, customer care, and safety procedures. A nominated manager will always be on duty to oversee compliance with the licence and act as the point of contact for the authorities and local residents. CCTV, staff training, and clear operational procedures will underpin our commitment to preventing crime and disorder, ensuring public safety, avoiding nuisance, and protecting children from harm.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A comprehensive CCTV system covering entry/exit points and customer areas, with recordings stored for a minimum of 31 days.

Staff trained to identify and deal with anti-social behaviour, refusing service if necessary.
Zero tolerance policy towards drugs or disorderly conduct.
Will reminding customers to behave responsibly and leave quietly

c) Public safety

Regular fire risk assessments and compliance with fire safety regulations, including extinguishers, emergency lighting, and signage.

Staff trained in emergency evacuation procedures and first aid.

Seating and furniture arranged to avoid blocking exits or pedestrian access.

Electrical and kitchen equipment tested and maintained to safety standards.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Outdoor seating managed to ensure customers do not obstruct the pavement or disturb neighbours.

Furniture will be removed and stored inside at closing time.

Customers encouraged to leave quietly

Waste managed responsibly with regular cleaning of the frontage and pavement area.

Deliveries and collections arranged at appropriate times to minimise disturbance.

e) The protection of children from harm

The café is a family-friendly environment with no adult entertainment or activities unsuitable for children.

Staff trained to safeguard children and report concerns to the appropriate authorities.

Children will not be permitted on the premises unaccompanied during late hours.



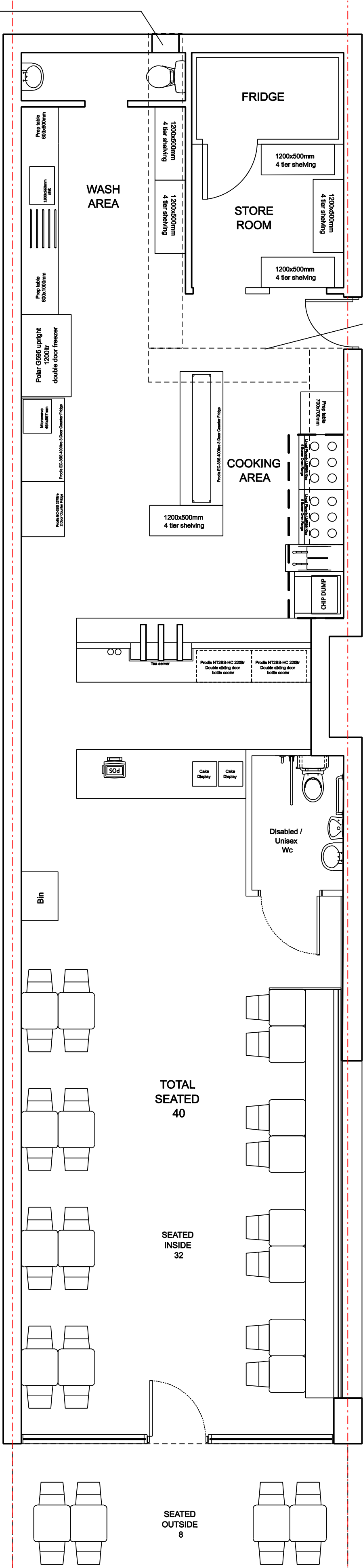

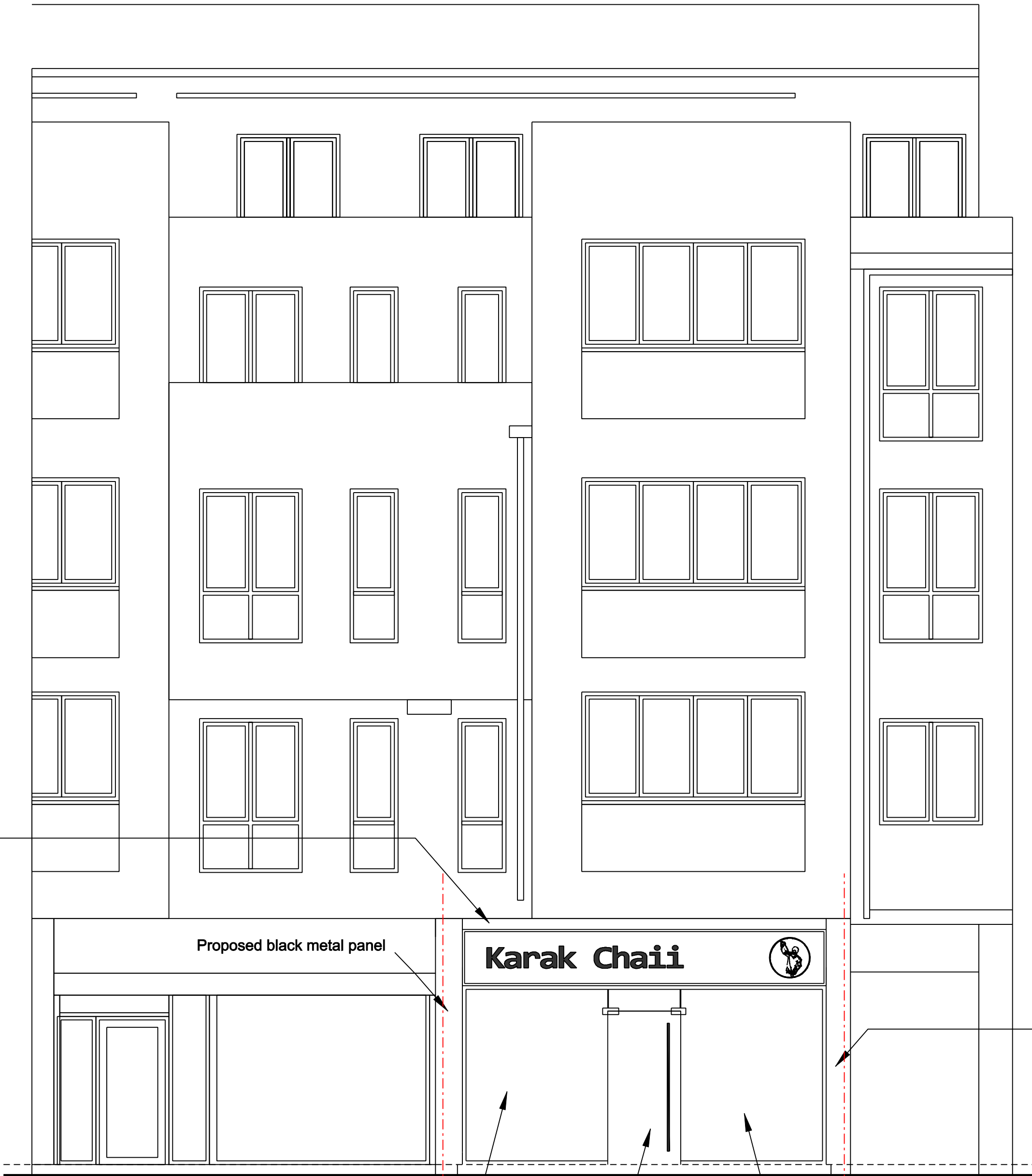
