Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

We are a bakery selling pastries and coffee with some bottles of wine for display and sale on the shelves. We will make sure that all purchasers of alcohol are ID'd and no alcohol is sold to anyone under the age of 18 years old .We will also make sure we do not serve alcohol to anyone who is under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will have CCTV installed both in the store and outside. This will act as deterrent to potential bad behaviour. We will also not sell alcohol to people who are acting in an intimdating manner and we will not sell alcohol to anyone underage or inebriated. We will keep a log of any incidents of criminal behaviour and report and incidents to the police and make a log in our book of such incidents.

c) Public safety

We will make sure large gatherings do not take place on or near the premise and we will not sell or serve alcohol to groups that may course public disorder. We will report and criminal activity and report any suspicious behaviour. All our staff will be first aid trained and will be aware to not sell alcohol to underage or inebriated individuals.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We will make sure we do not have people drinking outside the premise or making any noise that may disrupt the neighbours. We will not sell alcohol to large groups and will not sell alcohol to anyone who is showing signs of erratic behaviour.

e) The protection of children from harm

We will not sell any alcohol to anybody below the age of 18 and anyone who looks under the age of 25 we will make sure they are ID'd. All our staff will be fully trained to ensure this practise is carried out in the strictest manner. We will make a log of anyone who tries to illegally purchase alcohol and anyone under the legal age will not be served alcohol.
