Proposed 20mph Speed Limits Amendments

A. The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.1) Order 20**

- 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Hounslow propose to make the above-mentioned Orders, under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The general effect of these Orders would be to:
 - (a) make the following speed limit amendments:
 - revoke the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "High Street, Brentford", between it's junctions with The Ham and Goat Wharf in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 2019;
 - (ii) revoke the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Lampton Road, Hounslow", between its junction with Bath Road and the northern boundary of No. 69 Lampton Road, Hounslow in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2016;
 - (iii) revoke the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "London Road, Brentford", from a point outside No. 279 London Road to outside No. 142 London Road, Brentford in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2017:
 - (iv) revoke the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Sutton Lane, Hounslow", from its junction with Sarsen Avenue to the common boundary of Nos. 14/16 Sutton Lane, Hounslow in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2019;
 - (v) revoke the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Wellington Road South, Hounslow", the service road fronting Nos. 199 to 233, Wellington Road South, Hounslow in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.2) Order 2019;
 - (vi) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "High Street, Brentford", from the central boundary of Brentford Bridge, Grand Union Canal in an easterly direction to and including its junction with Goat Wharf, Brentford:
 - (vii) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Lampton Road, Hounslow", from and including its junction with Bath Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Jersey Road, Hounslow;
 - (viii) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "London Road, Brentford", from a point 10.5 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 491/491a London Road in an easterly direction to the central boundary of Brentford Bridge, Grand Union Canal, Brentford;
 - (ix) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Sutton Lane, Hounslow", from a point 44 metres north of the common boundary of Nos. 139/141 Sutton Lane in a southwestern direction to a point 29.5m north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Bath Road;
 - (x) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Wellington Road North, Hounslow", from the common boundary of Nos. 1/3 Wellington Road North in a southerly direction to its junction with Staines Road, Hounslow; and
 - (xi) introduce the 20mph speed limit in the length of road "Wellington Road South, Hounslow", from its junction with Staines Road in a southerly direction, including the

Statement of Reasons

20mph Speed Limit Specific Proposals

As part of the borough-wide road safety initiative, the Council is proposing to extend the existing 20mph zones on High Street, and London Road, Brentford, Lampton Road, Sutton Lane, Wellington Road North, and Wellington Road South, Hounslow. The proposed extended zones are:

High Street will cover the length of the road between its junction with Goat Wharf and Brentford Bridge, Brentford;

London Road will cover the length of the road between a point 10.5 metres east of the common boundary of Nos. 491/491a London Road and Brentford Bridge, Brentford; Lampton Road will cover the length of the road between its junctions with Bath Road and Jersey Road, Hounslow;

Sutton Lane will cover the length of the road between its junctions with Bath Road and Great West Road. Hounslow:

Wellington Road North will cover the length of the road between its junctions Bath Road and Staines Road, Hounslow; &


Wellington Road South will cover the length of the road between its junctions Staines Road and Hanworth Road, Hounslow.


20mph Speed Limit General Information

The Council recognises the benefits that lower vehicle speeds have on improving road safety on road within the borough. Lower vehicle speeds reduce the severity of injuries and the likelihood of them. Research suggests that a 1% reduction in the average speed can reduce collision frequency by 6%.


It is expected that the proposed measures will create a safer environment for all road users and will be of particular benefit to vulnerable road users, including cyclists and pedestrians, the younger and older people and those with disabilities.



- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 December 2019 and may be cited as the London Borough of Hounslow (20 mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2019.
- 2. The length of road "Grove Road between a point opposite the boundary of Nos.110 and 112 Grove Road and its junction with Inverness Road" item 4 in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.1) Order 2007^b is hereby revoked
- 3. The length of road "Bell Road, Hounslow (between its junction with Grove Road and its junction with High Street)" item 2 e) in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2016° is hereby revoked.
- 4. The length of road "Bedford Close entire length of public highway" in the Schedule of The London Borough of Hounslow (20mph Speed Limit) (No.4) Order 2017^d is hereby revoked.
- 5. No person shall drive a motor vehicle exceeding the speed of 20 miles per hour in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
