Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

- The premises will open in strict compliance with the licensing Act 2003 and Local Authority guidelines.
- All staff will receive training on the licensing objectives.
- An incident log and refusals log will be maintained and made available for inspection.
- The premises will operate a challenge 25 policy for alcohol supply and display prominent notices regarding licensing rules at all key point.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- CCTV will be installed in all main customer areas and entrances/exits with recordings maintained for at least 30 days. Footages will be supplied to police or authorized officers upon request.
- All staff will receive induction and refresher training in the prevention of crime and disorder, including procedures for refusing service to intoxicated customers, handling aggressive behaviour, and reporting suspicious activity.
- Alcohol will not be sold to any customer appearing intoxicated.
- Alcohol will not be permitted to be consumed in any outdoor areas not designated for such.
- Staff will challenge and refuse entry to anyone threatening public order.
- Alcohol will not be sold to any customer appearing intoxicated
- Staff will challenge and refuse entry to anyone threatening public order.

c) Public safety

- Fire exits will be clearly marked and unobstructed, and regular fire safety checks will be conducted
- Capacity will not exceed 30 seats; overcrowding will be prevented by monitoring entry and seating.
- First aid equipment will be maintained, and staff designated as first aiders will be present during operating hours.
- Any accident or safety incident will be recorded and reported as required.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- External doors and windows will be kept closed during live or recorded music (except for customer access and egress).
- Signage will request patrons to leave quietly and respect neighbors, particularly after 21:00.
- Deliveries and waste collection will only be scheduled between 08:00 and 20:00.
- Staff will ensure the immediate perimeter is free from litter and anti-social behavior regularly throughout and after service.

e) The protection of children from harm

- Alcohol will only be sold to those aged 18 or over, with Challenge 25 enforced and ID checks for any customer appearing under 25.
- Unaccompanied children under 16 will not be permitted on-site after 21:00.
- All staff will be trained in safeguarding and recognising signs of child vulnerability or abuse, with clear instructions for escalating concerns.
- Prominent signage will discourage the purchase of alcohol for underage persons.

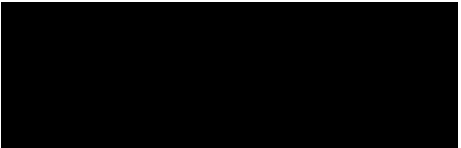
