Notice of Examination Hearings

The Hounslow Local Plan 2020 - 2041 was submitted by the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow to the Secretary of State for Examination on 23 June 2025. The Secretary of State has appointed **J Ayres BA(Hons), Solicitor** and **G Wildgoose BSc(Hons) MSc MRTPI** to carry out the Independent Examination.

Dates of Hearings

The examination hearings (Stage 1) will take place on the week beginning Monday 12 January 2026, with the first hearing session commencing on Tuesday 13 January 2026 at 10am with the intention of sitting until Friday 16 January 2026 that week. The second week of hearings will resume on Tuesday 27 January 2026 until Friday 30 January 2026.

Format of Hearings

The hearings will take place at: Council Chamber - Room 6.10, Hounslow House, 7 Bath Road, Hounslow, Middlesex, TW3 3EB (unless detailed otherwise on the [Examination website](#)).

Relevant guidelines in force at the time of the hearings will be in operation, together with any restrictions that are specific to the venue. The eligible participants in the hearing sessions are those who made relevant representations on the Plan and have confirmed to the Programme Officer that they wish to speak. All those who wish to speak at the hearing sessions should confirm this in writing or by e-mail to the Programme Officer by 5pm on Monday 8 December 2025 quoting their respondent reference number.

The hearing sessions will also be available for non-participants and the public to observe in person, subject to the capacity of the venue.
