Proposed Zebra Crossings associated Zig-Zag markings Sutton Lane, Hounslow, and Speed Tables Sutton Lane, Hounslow

1. The London Borough of Hounslow GIVES NOTICE in exercise of the powers under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to:-
 - a) Introduce Zebra Crossings and associated zig-zag markings in the following locations:
 - a. Sutton Lane, Hounslow between Deane Avenue and Bulstrode Avenue:
 - i. North-eastern kerb-line, from a point 1.2 metres north-east of the common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane in a north-eastern direction for a distance of 17.5 metres;
 - ii. South-western kerb-line from a point 1.2 metres north-east of the common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane in a north-eastern direction for a distance of 16.5 metres;
 - iii. North-eastern kerb-line, from a point 7.2 metres south-west of the common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane in a south-western direction for a distance of 17.5 metres; &
 - iv. South-western kerb-line, from a point 7.2 metres south-west of the common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane in a south-western direction for a distance of 17.5 metres.
 - b. Sutton Lane, Hounslow between Bulstrode Avenue and Harte Road:
 - i. North-eastern kerb-line, from a point 5.6 metres north-east of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane in a north-eastern direction for a distance of 17.2 metres;
 - ii. South-western kerb-line, from a point 5.6 metres north-east of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane in a north-eastern direction for a distance of 17.2 metres;
 - iii. North-eastern kerb-line, from a point 2.8 metres south-west of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane in a south-western direction for a distance of 17.2 metres; &
 - iv. South-western kerb-line, from a point 2.8 metres south-west of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane in a south-western direction for a distance of 17.2 metres.
2. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that The London Borough of Hounslow propose, under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct flat-top road humps (also known as a "speed table") in:
 - a) Sutton Lane, Hounslow between Deane Avenue and Bulstrode Avenue:
 - a. Northern end: common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane; &
 - b. Southern end: 6.0 m south of the common property boundary line between Nos. 42 and 44 Sutton Lane.
 - b) Sutton Lane, Hounslow between Bulstrode Avenue and Harte Road:
 - a. Northern end: 4.4 m north of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane; &

- b. Southern end: 1.6 m south of the common building line between Nos. 65 and 67 Sutton Lane.
3. The flat-top road humps would extend across both sides of Sutton Lane, Hounslow with a maximum height of 75mm, maximum centreline plateau length of 6.0 m, and a maximum front and rear slopes of 1 in 16 as per the below table:

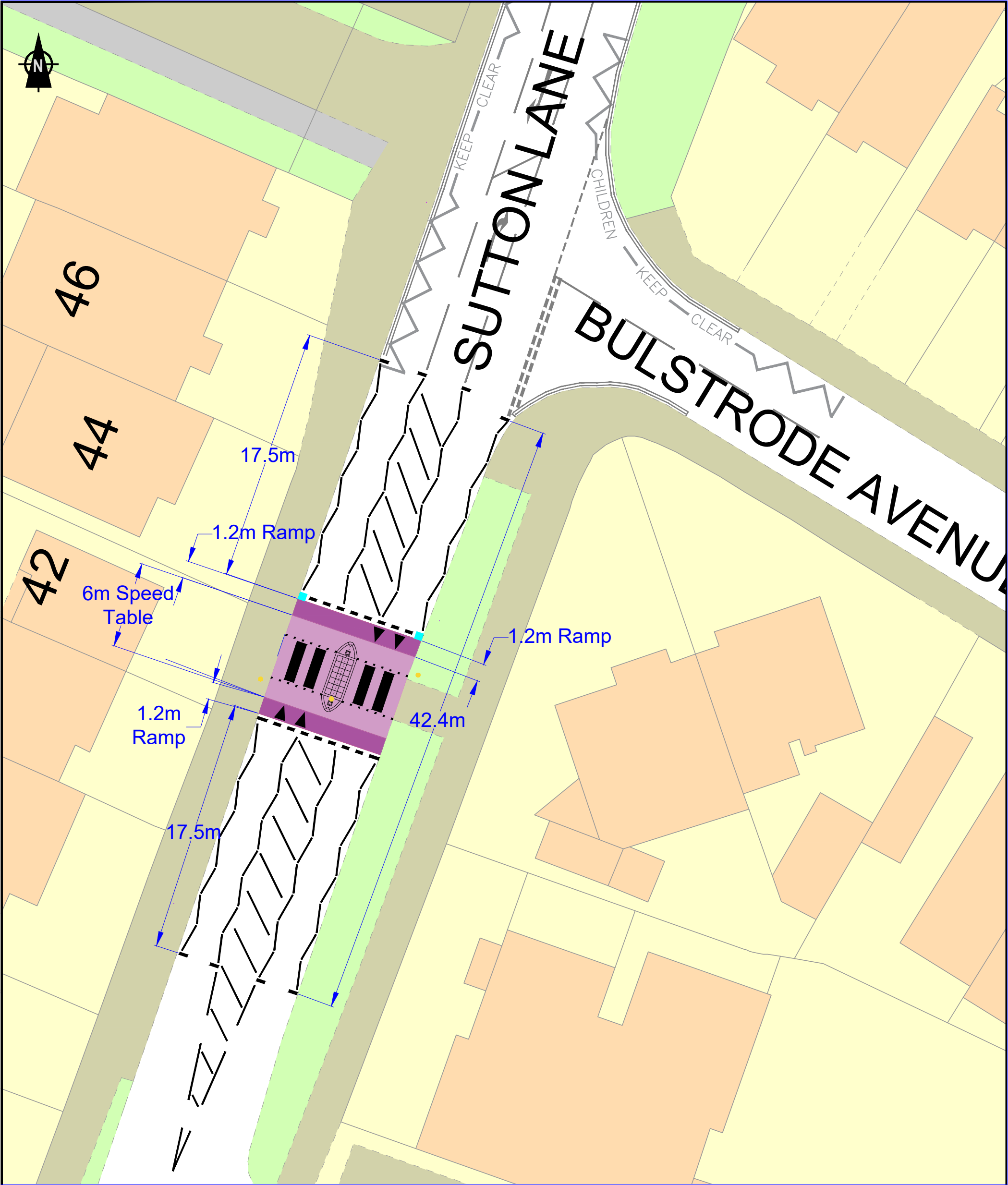
STATEMENT OF REASONS

Proposed Zebra Crossings associated Zig-Zag markings Sutton Lane, Hounslow, and Speed Tables Sutton Lane, Hounslow

The Council is committed to improving road safety and accessibility for all residents. As part of the package of traffic improvements for Hounslow, we have developed a design to upgrade the existing zebra crossings on Sutton Lane (between Dene Avenue and Harte Road, Hounslow) to a raised crossings over speed tables.

This improvement will not only provide added safety benefits for pedestrians but also help reduce vehicle speeds when the crossing is not in use, acting as a permanent speed reduction feature.

Sutton Lane currently has a 20-mph speed limit, and this traffic calming measure will help ensure better compliance. The change will also create a level surface, making it easier and safer for pedestrians, wheelchair users, pushchair users, and other vulnerable road users to cross.

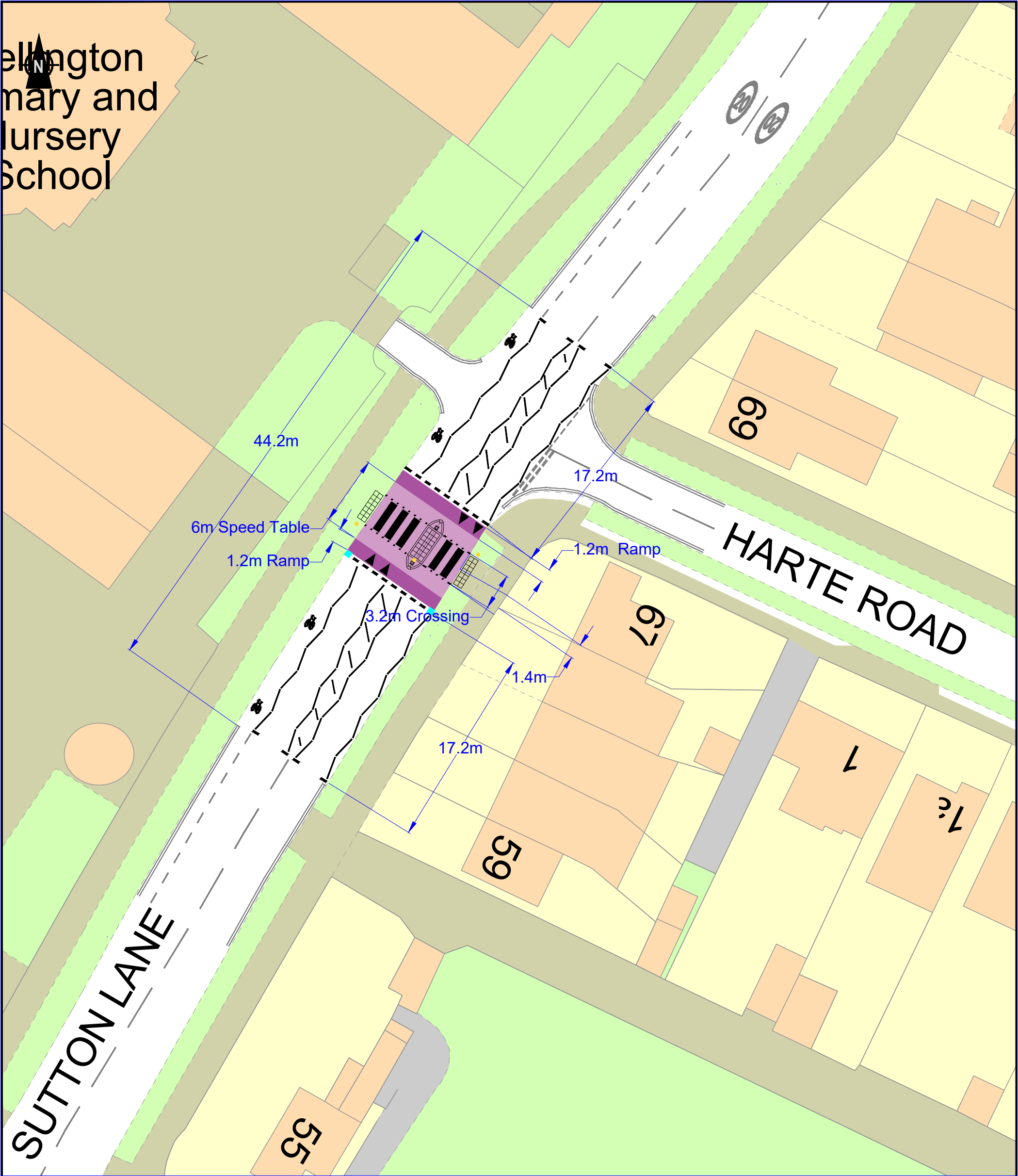
