Fish and Spice is a single-storey restaurant located at 773 London Road, Hounslow. The premises operate as a fully seated restaurant providing freshly prepared meals to customers. Alcohol will be served ancillary to meals to customers seated at tables. The restaurant has seating areas, customer toilets, and kitchen facilities. All licensable activities will take place indoors. There is no vertical drinking or bar-only service.

The premises operate within standard fire safety requirements, with marked fire exits, emergency lighting, and occupancy limits always observed. The proposed hours for the supply of alcohol are 11:00 to 23:00. All alcohol will be supplied responsibly in line with Challenge 25 and other licensing objectives.

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

Fish and Spice is a fully seated restaurant. Alcohol will be served only to diners at tables alongside meals. Staff will be trained in licensing law, responsible alcohol sales, and customer safety. Written procedures cover age verification, incident reporting, and refusal of alcohol. The designated premises supervisor (DPS), Neel Thaker, will oversee compliance. Signage will be displayed, and all reasonable measures will be taken to meet licensing objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV will cover entrances and main seating areas, with recordings kept for 28 days. A refusals and incident log will be maintained. Alcohol will only be served to seated diners, and no bar-only service will occur. Staff are trained in age checks and refusal procedures.

c) Public safety

The premises comply with fire and health & safety regulations. Fire exits and escape routes are marked and unobstructed. Staff are trained in emergencies, occupancy limits will be observed, and first aid equipment is available. Regular safety checks will be carried out.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Customers will be asked to leave quietly. Notices will remind patrons to minimise noise. No outdoor drinking after 23:00. Deliveries and waste collection will be managed to reduce late-night disturbance. Doors and windows will remain closed after 22:00, and only background music will be played.

e) The protection of children from harm

A Challenge 25 policy will be followed. Acceptable ID includes passport, driving licence, or PASS card. Staff are trained in age-restricted sales, and a refusals log is maintained. Children may only dine when accompanied by an adult.


