### Conditions:

1. The premises will install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system covering all parts of the premises as per the minimum requirements of the Metropolitan Police. Further:
  - a. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition.
  - b. The CCTV system will continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises.
  - c. All recordings will be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping.
  - d. Viewing of recordings will be made available immediately upon request of the Metropolitan Police or an authorised officer of The London Borough of Hounslow throughout the preceding 31 day period, providing the request complies with the Data Protection Act 2018 or any other Primary Legislation
  - e. All searches will be recorded on the CCTV system
  - f. There will be external CCTV (installed and operated) which monitors the queue, smoking area and entrance and exit.
  - g. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system will be always on the premises when the premises are open. This staff member will be able to provide a constable of the Metropolitan Police or an authorised officer of The London Borough of



6. Ingress and egress notwithstanding, all doors and windows shall remain closed during any regulated entertainment and/or after 22:00 in all circumstances. Staff shall undertake regular checks to ensure that all doors and windows are closed
7. A telephone number shall be made available to be used by residents in relation to any complaint of noise resulting from the premises. The premises licence holder shall ensure that all complaints made by residents, and any action taken, are recorded within the incident log.
8. Noise and litter monitoring shall be undertaken at least once every two hours when regulated entertainment is provided from 23.00 until the closure of the premises
9. No rubbish or empty bottles shall be placed in the outside bins after 23:00.
10. A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport, or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
11. A log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of The London Borough of Hounslow or the Metropolitan Police, which will record the following:
  - a. all crimes reported to the venue
  - b. all ejections of patrons
  - c. any complaints received concerning crime and disorder
  - d. any faults in the CCTV system or searching equipment
  - e. any refusal of the sale of alcohol
  - f. any visit by a relevant authority, Metropolitan Police, London Ambulance Service or The London Fire Brigade.
  - g. any CCTV images seized by Metropolitan Police or other relevant authority or supplied by license holder on request, including name of person requesting and name of person supplying
  - h. any refusal of admission
  - i. any refusal to sell alcohol
  - j. any acts of violence or criminal damage
  - k. any theft or attempted theft of alcoholic drinks
12. No children shall be admitted unless accompanied by a responsible adult
13. There shall be no admittance or re-admittance to the premises less than 1 hour before the end of licensable activities.

14. The premises licence holder will devise and maintain the following policies:

- Dispersal

This policy will include but not limited to:

- i. How patrons leaving the premises will be directed away from the premises;
- ii. How patrons will be informed of the services of taxi and private hire operators;
- iii. What staff will be responsible for supervising those leaving the premises and how they will supervise such persons;
- iii. Any 'wind' down periods;
- iv. Methods to prevent re-entry to the premises;
- v. How bottles and glasses will be prevented from being removed from the premises at closing time.

- Security

This policy will include but not limited to:

- i. Clear expectations of staff roles (including the DPS, managers/supervisors and door supervisors);
- ii. Staff training regarding identification of suspicious activity and what action to take;
- iii. Searching as a preventative measure to prevent patrons from bringing in any illicit drugs, weapons, or any other unlawful items onto the premises. Such measures shall include the use of a detection wand.

- Drugs, this will be a zero-tolerance policy with regard to the use/possession of controlled drugs and psychoactive substances

Including but not limited to:

- i. Dealing with patrons suspected of using drugs on the premises;
- ii. Scrutiny of spaces including toilets or outside areas;
- iii. The handling of items suspected to be illegal drugs or psychoactive substances.
- v. Steps taken to discourage and disrupt drug use on the premises
- vi. Steps to be taken to inform patrons of the premises drug policy/practice.
- vii. How the venue will legal dispose of or surrender to the Metropolitan Police any sized items.

- Weapons this will be a zero-tolerance policy with regard to the use/possession of weapons

In the event that changes are made to any of the policies a further copy will be lodged with the Licensing Authority within 7 days of the changes taking effect.

15. When SIA are employed at the premises the licence holder will:

16. The premises licence holder will ensure that all staff are trained commensurate with their roles at the premises including:

  - c. Welfare and Vulnerability Engagement (WAVE) training
  - d. Counter terrorism training
