40mph and 50mph Speed Limit Consolidation

The London Borough of Hounslow (40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2026

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The London Borough of Hounslow on the 18 March 2026 has made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of and Part III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order will come into force on 10 April 2026.
2. The general effect of this Order will be to revoke and reintroduce the provisions of all previous 40 and 50 mph speed limit Orders into a new consolidation Order without any change to the substance of the prohibitions in the London Borough of Hounslow.
3. All made documents can be viewed online at hounslow.gov.uk by typing in the term “traffic notices” in the search bar and at Hounslow Library, Hounslow House First Floor, 7 Bath Road, TW3 3EB or at The Reception of Hounslow House, Ground Floor, 7 Bath Road, TW3 3EB on Mondays and Thursdays between 9.30am and 8pm, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays between 9.30am and 5.30pm or on Sundays between 11.30am and 4.00pm.
4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

Traffic Management Order

The London Borough of Hounslow (40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2026

Made on 18 March 2026

Coming into operation on 10 April 2026

The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 84(1) and 84(2) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a as amended, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Citation and Commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Hounslow (40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2026 and shall come into operation for all purposes on 10 April 2026.

2. Interpretation

- (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

“Beacon Road Roundabout” means the carriageway comprised within the roundabout situated at the junctions of Bedfont Road (Western Arm) with Sanctuary Road (North-Western Arm), Beacon Road (Northern Arm), Unnamed Access Road for Heathrow Park & Ride Parking Terminal 4 (North-Eastern Arm), Stanwell Road (South-Eastern Arm), and Unnamed Access Road for Dnata City East (South-Western Arm);

“Clockhouse Roundabout” means the carriageway comprised within the roundabout situated at the junctions of A30/A315 Staines Road with A30 Great South-West Road, Bedfont Road and B3003 Clockhouse Lane.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

3. Prohibition

- (1) Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (2) Save as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

4. Exemptions

- (1) Nothing in this Order shall apply in respect of any vehicle on the occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if observance of that provision would hinder the use of that vehicle.

SCHEDULE 1
40mph Speed Limit

1. **Bedfont Road, Feltham** –
 - (a) between a point 75 metres north-west of the north-western kerb-line of Chertsey Road and its junction with Staines Road and Clockhouse Roundabout;
 - (b) from the boundary of the Administrative County of Surrey to its junction with the western arm of the Beacon Road Roundabout;
2. **Clockhouse Lane (B3003), Feltham** – from a point, on the north-west side, 25.6 metres north-east of the boundary of the Administrative County of Surrey to its junction with Clockhouse Roundabout;
3. **Snakey Lane, Feltham** – between a point 40 metres east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Sunbury Road and a point 72 metres west of the north-western kerb-line of Kampton Park Water Treatment Works, Snakey Lane;
4. **Stanwell Road, Feltham** – from its junction with Bedfont Road, the western arm of the Beacon Road Roundabout, including the Beacon Road Roundabout, to its junction with the A30 Great South-West Road and
5. **Windmill Lane (B454), Isleworth** – from a point 313 metres north of the centre line of Jersey Road to the borough boundary with the London Borough of Ealing.

SCHEDULE 2
50mph Speed Limit

1. **The Parkway (A312), Hounslow** –
 - (a) between the northern edge of the circulatory carriageway of its interchange with the M4 motorway and the southern edge of the circulatory carriageway of its interchange with the Bulls Bridge Roundabout; and
 - (b) between the northern edge of the circulatory carriageway of its interchange with the Bulls Bridge Roundabout and the boundary with the London Borough of Hillingdon.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order revokes and reintroduces the provisions of all previous 40mph and 50mph speed limit Orders into a new consolidation Order without any change to the substance of the prohibitions in the London Borough of Hounslow.
