Notice of Examination Hearings

Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 Statutory Instrument No.767 Regulation 24

Date of Notice: 27 March 2026

The Hounslow Local Plan 2020 - 2041 was submitted by the Council of the London Borough of Hounslow to the Secretary of State for Examination on 23 June 2025. The Secretary of State has appointed **J Ayres BA(Hons), Solicitor** and **G Wildgoose BSc(Hons) MSc MRTPI** to carry out the Independent Examination.

Dates of Hearings

The examination hearings (Stage 2) will take place on the week beginning Monday 11 May 2026, with the first hearing session commencing on Tuesday 12 May 2026 at 10:00am with the intention of sitting until Thursday 14 May 2026 that week. The second week of hearings will resume on Tuesday 16 June 2026 until Thursday 18 June 2026. The third week of hearings will resume on Tuesday 30 June 2026 until Thursday 2 July 2026.

Format of Hearings

The first week of the Stage 2 hearings will take place at: The Treaty Centre - Level 2 Office Space, 44 High Street, Hounslow, TW3 1ES.

The second and third weeks of the Stage 2 hearings will take place at: Council Chamber - Room 6.10, Hounslow House, 7 Bath Road, Hounslow, TW3 3EB.

Relevant guidelines in force at the time of the hearings will be in operation, together with any restrictions that are specific to the venues. The eligible participants in the hearing sessions are those who made relevant representations on the Plan at Regulation 19 consultation stage and have confirmed to the Programme Officer that they wish to speak. All those who wish to speak at the hearing sessions should confirm this in writing or by e-mail to the Programme Officer by 5pm on Monday 20 April 2026 quoting their respondent reference number.

The hearing sessions will also be available for non-participants and the public to observe in person, subject to the capacity of the venues.
