b) The prevention of crime and disorder

To prevent crime and disorder, we will notify local authority of our operating hours so they are aware we are open if any situation were to occur. We will not allow any persons not collecting or placing an order to hang around inside or within the vicinity surrounding the restaurant. We have CCTV cameras installed to monitor the entire restaurant as well as the front and back entrances.

c) Public safety

For public safety, we will have bright lighting indoors and clear signage of our restaurant to welcome customers and we will keep external back doors and internal doors separating customers from our staff locked at all times. Staff are fully aware of emergency procedures and fire alarms and extinguishers are regularly checked and are in compliance with health and safety regulations.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

As we are a food takeaway restaurant, we will urge customers to swiftly collect their food and leave the premises so they are not encourage to hang around inside or nearby the restaurant. No music will be played at all times and staff will keep noise levels down as to not disturb anyone in the surrounding area. Bins are located along the street in front of the shops so customers will be urged to utilise them if needed. The stores lighting from the outside will not be too bright or harsh as to not create any light pollution.

e) The protection of children from harm

To protect children from harm, we will guarantee that there will be no alcohol on the premises.
